

Important Safety Precautions

All reclining furniture has moving parts and can be **dangerous** if misused.

LEG REST: Folds down on closing.

TO AVOID INJURY: Check carefully for obstructions. Ensure the leg rest is always in the closed position whenever the chair is not in use.

MOVING PARTS: Can pinch fingers. To avoid injury please be careful of moving parts and ensure pets are kept at a safe distance.

CHILDREN: We recommend you don't allow children to operate the chair.

USAGE: This product is NOT intended for rental use or for use in business institutions, as medical aids or other heavy duty applications. It is only for personal use in the owner's home. Maximum safe weight limit 120kg.

- Recliners should only be operated when occupied by one person after checking that children and pets are not in the vicinity and ensuring that there is sufficient space for operation without any obstructions. The reclining mechanism should **never** be released without sitting in the seat.
- Before returning the mechanism to its closed position, care should be taken to check that children or pets have not entered into the vicinity.
- Do not sit on the arms or the open footrest.
- Always ensure that the furniture is properly closed before attempting to move it. **Never** move the furniture when it is open and do not drag by an open footrest or reclined backrest.
- Never drop or insert any object into any opening.
- The mechanism is designed to be used by one person. Do not overload.

Power Mechanisms - Additional Safety Guidelines

- Do not leave unattended when plugged in. Unplug from the mains when not in use.
- Always ensure that all wires are free and not trapped in any way.
- If wires become damaged, have them replaced by a qualified electrician, consult your retailer.
- Keep wires and handsets away from heated surfaces.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being used.
